Driving How To Find Us : From 115 going south and coming off 407 going towards the south . First exit after the 407 , stay in the lane coming off the ramp, it will exit right onto the 7th conc. Take the First left about 75 m or 250-300ft, it will be a bridge , follow over top of the 115 , will lead to a stop sign . Turn right at Stop Sign approx. 10 km past village of Kendal , slightly past Soper Rd , 3 rd Driveway Red Barn and Sign for H. Richardson Farms turn in and proceed to Barn , call or enter the front or side door , if locked call 905-396-2801 or try and use the phones on North and East wall Dial O for service. **From 115 Northbound :** Approx 13 km from 401 and 115 (interchange 436) , as you are passing a Exit for 8th Line Clark and Cat World , you will notice a Gas station , keep going past and notice Windmills , road veers to left , NEXT EXIT to the Right in approxametely 1km, from curve , quick exit will say Brimacombe ski Club , Rd 9 , get into exit lane ,pass under bridge and Exit . Stay straight on Durham Rd 9 (Ganaraska Rd.) for approx. 10km past village of Kendal , slightly past Soper Rd , 3 rd Driveway Red Barn and Sign for H. Richardson Farms turn in and proceed to Barn , call or enter the front or side door , if locked call 905-396-2801 or try and use the phones on North and East wall Dial O for service
